

Eucharist Minister

Everyone 18 years or older is encouraged to become a communion minister. Being a minister lets us participate in the celebration of the Eucharist in a special way. Eucharistic ministers help the celebrant by distributing the Body and Blood in communion at Mass. Some training is necessary and ministers choose a particular mass time for a month during the year. All ministers become a part of the substitute list, to be called in the event that a minister can not be at a Mass during his/her month. Ministers are commissioned for a three year period.
