The Social Concerns Committee organizes projects and collections to assist those in need. The goal of the group is to put the words of Jesus Christ into action. Some of the projects are “hands-on”. This can include helping with a local meal site, cleaning and painting a room in a shelter or participating in a walk for hunger. Monthly collections have assisted local, national, and international agencies. Local programs that have been helped include local food pantries, Project Now, Crisis Pregnancy Center and Christian Family Care Center. We have a fundraiser garage sale in the spring with the money directed towards a multitude of needs. Meetings are held monthly on the second Monday of each month, in the Believers Together Center, to discuss collections and projects for the coming months.
